## Shooter of the Year Tournament Dates

To be eligible for Shooter of The Year archers must post scores from 7 tournaments. These scores will be the best of:

4 Spot Tournaments (each is pro-rated to a maximum of 300 points)

2 Circuit 3D Tournaments (raw score)

The SC State 3D Championship (raw score)

Shooter of the Year is awarded to the Archer with the highest cumulative score from the 7 events.

Class winners are awarded a Shooter of the Year trophy.
