Entry Fees, Awards, and Classes:

All Entry fees go towards money payback or trophies. Awards will be presented at the End of Year Award Banquet.

\$50 (Money Award)- Open Pro, Known 50

\$25 (Money Award)- Open, Known 40 Outlaw, Women's Known, Women's Open, Hunter Unlimited, Senior Open (50-64), Super Senior Open (65up), Senior Known, Bowhunter Novice, Women's Bowhunter, High School Boys Open, High School Girls Open, Traditional, High School NASP, Traditional.

\$10 (Trophy)- Middle School Open, Middle School NASP, Elem. School Open, Pee Wee (8 & under) & Elem. NASP



Money Award Distribution: 1-3 archers-first place;
4-6 archers-first & second place,
7 or more-first, second, & third place.

Trophy Award Distribution: 1-4 archers-first place;
5-8 archers-first & second place,
9 or more-first, second, & third place..

Competition Scoring:

The 3D Circuit points champion will be the one with the highest combined total score (the highest score from each club and the added points from the SC StateD Championship). If a competitor competes in more than 3 3D Circuit Tournaments, the 3 highest points and the State 3D are used for the cumulative score. **Each participant must have at least one score from each club in order to qualify along with the SC 3D Championship Shoot.** A scoreboard for the 3D Circuit will be kept on the SCAA website. Competitors should notify the SCAA 3D Circuit Representative for corrections. (Please do not wait to the end of the year to review these.) a. If a 3D Circuit member is not a member of the SCAA, he/she may participate in the State 3D as a guest. Circuit members may join the SCAA and participate as a full SCAA member. b. 3D Circuit members must join on or before the second circuit tournament. c. Tournaments only count towards circuit championship after registration is done.

Note: *Circuit Shooters are not required to join the SCAA. SCAA 3D Champions must be a current SCAA member. A Circuit member has the option of participating in the guest class if he/she chooses not to join. Scores will transfer over for points.*
