## Entry Fees, Classes, and Awards:

No additional fees except for event tournament fees. Must join SOY. Online form is on the SCAA website.

Must be a member of the SCAA.

SCAA 3D Classes are used. Bowhunter B is not recognized as a competitive class for Shooter of the Year. Archers must shoot in the comparable NFAA class for the NFAA/SCAA sanctioned events.

Class winners are awarded a Shooter of the Year trophy.

## Participation Requirements and Information

Participate in 4 of the first 6 State Tournaments. If competitor shoots more than 4 of these tournaments, the highest 4 scores are used to determine final score.

Participate in the final State 3D.

All tournament scores are prorated to a score of 900. The Final State 3D is not prorated.

Vegas= actual score x 1.5

Indoor= actual score x 1.5

International= actual score x 3

Hunter= actual score x (900/560)

900=actual score (not prorated)

Field= actual score x (900/560)

3D= actual score (not prorated)

Shooter of the Year is awarded to the archer with the highest summed score.
